Course Description

Organizations need employees who can help leaders identify and prioritize strategic issues and then launch and execute projects to accomplish strategic objectives. The field of *Strategic Improvement* continues to evolve with the integration of Lean and Six Sigma, the growing importance of Strategic Planning and Innovation, and the emergence of Big Data Analytics and AI. A *Strategic Improvement Black Belt* possesses knowledge and skills in these and other areas. One of the *best practice* project execution approaches is *Lean Six Sigma*. This approach combines the "*waste out*" Lean techniques with the structured Six Sigma problemsolving method and tools to provide leaders with a way to improve both efficiency and effectiveness. This ten day *Strategic Improvement Black Belt* course prepares participants for this organizational role through nine days of application-oriented training, practical assignments, project work, a final presentation, and a rigorous final exam. Participants will take their *Strategic Improvement* expertise to the *next level* and prepare themselves for the *Strategic Improvement Master Black Belt* level of mastery.
